

Questions for CEEED 5-year Review

The purpose of this list of questions is to help the programs under review understand the review criteria, and to help the CEEED Committee members familiarize themselves with the programs before the review meeting. It is not intended to create additional burden on the programs, so please answer these questions **concisely and briefly**.

- 1) Please describe any significant ways in which the program has changed since the proposal was written or since the last evaluation.

- 2) Do you have an example of a best practice that contributes to the success of your program?

- 3) Who makes up the target audience of the program, and where are they located? Is the program adequately reaching these students?

- 4) What are your retention rates and typical time to degree, and are these above/below what you see as ideal?

- 5) What items in the survey responses from faculty and students do you see as areas of concern, and how might you address them?

- 6) What items in the enrollment data provided do you see as areas of concern, and how might you address them?

- 7) What is the current demand for the off-campus program? Do you foresee that changing in the future?

- 8) Are there other issues of concern, such as resources, course offerings, advising, etc?

- 9) What changes are currently underway or planned for the program?

- 10) Where do you see the program in five years?
